The new Mazak 4,000-watt 5-axis laser cutting system can perform 2D and full 3D laser cutting and has a capacity of 131.6" x 60.8" x 28.3". This makes the fourth laser cutting system at the company. It is ideal for flat plate, formed or drawn shapes and tubing, pipe and structural items. The new DMG-Mori features a 2.4" diameter through the spindle, 15.1" max diameter, 20.2" max length, 10,000 rpm direct drive live tooling, and sub-spindle. "The certifications and new equipment demonstrate our commitment to technology and growth and further diversify our offerings to our customers," stated Eric Bruder, President & CEO.
